The Jerusalem Bible Institute



The purpose of the Jerusalem Bible Institute is to prepare the next generation of Messianic Jewish and Arab Christian leaders to impact Israeli culture. Our prayer is that God will embed our students in strategic places of influence for the spiritual transformation of our nation.

Our goal is to train them in both Word and Spirit alongside hands-on ministry experience. We are committed to teaching our students to properly interpret the Bible in its original context, apply its truths to the community of faith, and foster an atmosphere of spiritual renewal.

We want to raise up Spirit-led leaders who can apply the wisdom of God to every area of society. Our core courses will include both biblical and theological studies alongside practical ministry courses, such as preaching, counseling, leadership skills, and general education—including the Liberal Arts, and pastoral ministry.

In our teaching and practice, we emphasize:

CHARISMATIC: We teach immersion in the Holy Spirit and that the gifts of the Spirit are critical for congregational life and the promulgation of the Good News of the Kingdom with signs and wonders.

RESTORATIONIST: We are committed to the dual restoration of Israel and the Church. We believe that the modern-day restoration of the Jewish people to the Land of Israel and to faith in Yeshua is central to God's end-time purposes. Parallel to Israel's restoration, God is restoring the Church to its full stature in Messiah. We embrace our unity with our Arab Christian brothers in the Middle East and work with them to see the salvation of both the Jewish and Arab peoples (John 17:21).

MESSIANIC JEWISH: We seek to impart to our Israeli students a balanced understanding of Judaism and its traditions to equip them to make Biblically informed applications in the context of Messianic Jewish ministry in Israel.

REVIVALIST: We embrace the Moves of the Holy Spirit from Pentecost to the *Great Awakenings* of the eighteenth century, and more recent global revivals, immersion in the Holy Spirit, all the gifts of the Spirit, and the ascension ministry gifts of Ephesians 4:11-13.





A Unique Study Concept

The pressures on young Israelis makes it imperative for a flexible program for busy students. JBI has created a modern learning environment in which students can work and study simultaneously.

JBI offers a unique blend of online courses (with flexibility for the personal pace of each student). These are supported by evening Zoom meetings and in-person meetings that take place every other Friday and also long weekends every six weeks.

The online courses will be delivered by the latest state-of-the-art technology that allows students to study at their own pace, (watch video sessions during free time) and still be actively engaged in the collaborative learning experience

In-person meetings for fellowship and impartation

These are mandatory meetings that are essential for the successful spiritual journey of our students.

They will take place:

Every third Friday from 9:00-14:00 in Jerusalem

Every 6 weeks for an entire weekend in one of the locations in the Land

Included:

- a time of anointed worship and prayer to learn and experience the presence and power of the Holy Spirit
- Fellowship: small group discussions and fellowship during community meals
- Impartation and mentorship from experienced leaders and pastors from Israel and abroad

JBI Mentor Team

JBI integrates the local congregational community into your educational journey:

- Each student appoints their own personal mentor team that will steward them in their journey of discipleship and help to flourish in his or her vocation.
- A mentor team consists of two members: a JBI faculty mentor, and a personal mentor. Typically, personal mentors are known to the student and come from their local congregation.
- Mentors are mature followers of Yeshua. They commit themselves to being co-learners with the student and are available for them on an ongoing basis to support their spiritual journey

Academic Partnership

We have signed a *Memorandum of Understanding* with **Oral Roberts University** and are exploring ways for mutual blessing and cooperation

We have reached an agreement with **Kairos University** to offer BA and MA degrees

(BA in Christian Thought and Practice, and BA in Leadership)

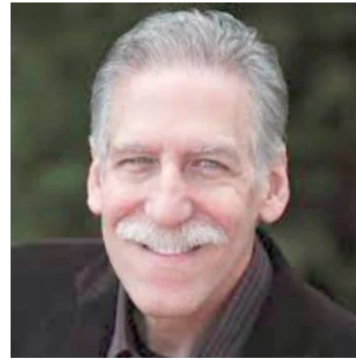
